During the ten years existence of this unique band – at least fourteen of its playing members have encountered this horrible disease and this makes us even more determined to raise what we can to enable the researchers to take another step towards finding the cure.

To date, we have raised £185,121 for charity - £160,679 for breast cancer research and £24,442 for other charities


