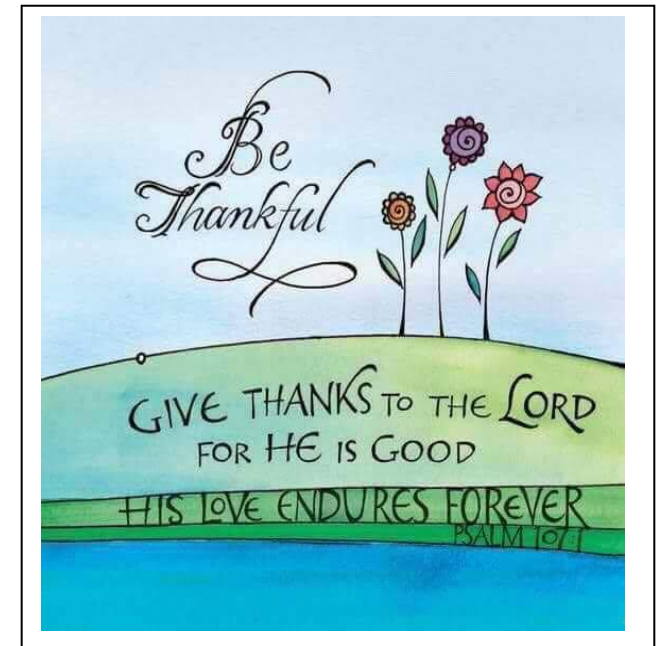

It was through the Ladies' Fellowship group that I first became aware of the Salvation Army's 'Helping Hand' project. This is an international charity which tackles gender based violence and inequality around the world and the Ladies' Fellowship supports their work.

It was in the early summer last year that I met with Jayne Webster and Lorraine Perkins (the group leaders) and we began to discuss the possibility of putting on a concert to raise funds for 'Helping Hand'. I spent the next two months inviting singers who I had worked with in the past to form a group, and weekly rehearsals began on Friday evenings in September. Sixteen of the group members are from Rushden and the surrounding area plus two singers who come from Bedford.

At the beginning of December we made an appearance in a short concert for family and friends and after hearing us performing, we asked members of the audience to suggest a name for the group - we were named "Perfect Resonance".
